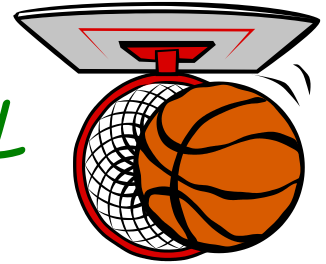


2010 - 2011 CYO BASKETBALL



Welcome a new CYO Sports Season – an exciting year with our young people of ministry through sports! Enclosed is important information for the coming season.

2010 – 2011 CYO ATHLETIC MANUAL

The *CYO Athletic Manual* is published annually for athletic directors and coaches. The manual contains philosophy, rules and information on all CYO sports. A copy is mailed to each athletic director and a copy will be given to each coach at certification workshops. Additional copies are available from the CYO Office.

BASKETBALL RULES CHANGES

Official rules for CYO are in the 2010–2011 CYO Athletic Manual and in the 2010–2011 National Federation High School rulebook, available from the CYO Office. There are no significant rules changes for the coming season.

INCREASE IN CYO TEAM FEES

Due to increased charges from the Cathedral Center and shortages in the overall diocesan budget, CYO team fees are increased \$20, to \$60 per team. This increase is about \$2 per player. If your school or parish cannot pay the new fee, please contact CYO to make arrangements.

ELIGIBILITY

- Review the CYO eligibility rules and check the eligibility of each player CAREFULLY. *It is important the athletic director check each child's eligibility to participate in your parish program prior to enrollment and practice.* Each child must meet all eligibility criteria including residence, grade and age, and have completed and returned all necessary applications, including the Parental Permission and Health Authorization forms. *The use of an ineligible player, knowingly or unknowingly, will result in game forfeiture and may result in additional sanctions as well.*

SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

It is required that all volunteers working with youth in the diocese complete Safe Environment Training and comply with diocesan safe environment policies:

- This year, all new CYO coaches will be required to complete Safe Environment Training prior to coaching certification. Returning coaches (those certified to coach in CYO during the 2009-2010 school year), are not required to repeat the course.
- Coaches may complete the Shield the Vulnerable course on-line, or attend a live training. The process for completing the training on line or finding a live training is on each workshop flyer or on the website: www.oakdiocese.org/safe/workshops.htm. The cost for on-line training is \$8.00 per coach. The Safe Environment Office will bill individual parishes. FINGERPRINTING / MEGAN'S LAW CHECKS / SCREENING AND SELECTING COACHES

Fingerprinting CYO Volunteers: The diocesan Safe Environment Office will continue the process of fingerprinting all volunteers with access to children, including CYO coaches, taking several years to complete. This coming season, new athletic directors, all third grade coaches and any new fourth grade coaches will be fingerprinted. (An athletic director is defined as one with supervisory responsibility over coaches.) Fingerprinting will be at the AD Seminar and several other dates prior to the start of the season. Fingerprinting will be by representatives of the Safe Environment Office. Cost is \$25 per person and individual CYO programs will be billed. By law, results are strictly confidential. Megan's Law Checks: Athletic directors shall check all volunteers. Megan's Law checks can be easily done "online" through the State of California sponsored website: <http://www.meganslaw.ca.gov>. The diocese will check all coaches registering at coaches' workshops through "Megan's Law," as well.

Volunteer Application: Prior to coaching, it is required that each coach complete a "CYO Volunteer Application". The application allows for screening and approval of coaches by the parish program. New coaches are required to complete this application form. The athletic director should then check application information. A copy of the application is to be kept on file with the parish or Catholic school.

TOURNAMENTS

- Information on CYO Tournaments will be posted when received on the CYO Website (www.oaklandcyo.org).
- CYO teams may not participate in leagues other than the CYO league as per insurance requirements. *Any tournament longer than three weekends will be considered to be a "league" and CYO teams will not be allowed to participate.*

2010 – 2011 SPORTS CALENDAR

The 2010–2011 CYO Sports Calendar is included with the dates for practice, tournaments and league play. More details regarding coaches certification workshops will be mailed prior to each season and posted on the website.

ORDERING FORMS AND RULE BOOKS

Use the attached CYO Form and Rulebook Order Form to order copies of CYO forms and to order 2010–2011 National Federation Basketball Rulebooks. Rulebooks may be purchased from the CYO Office for \$ 5.00 each. Return the Order Form to the CYO Office and indicate how and when you would like to pick up supplies. Normally, due to high cost of postage, supplies are **not** mailed. Forms are on line on the CYO website, forms page, and may be downloaded. There will be a "per copy charge" for forms that are ordered from CYO.

ATHLETIC DIRECTORY FORM

A copy of the Athletic Directory Form is included for your use as you begin to recruit basketball coaches for the coming season. When you have completed the form, return it to the CYO Office. The CYO Office must receive directory forms by *FRIDAY, OCTOBER 22* to be included in the 2010–2011 Basketball Coaches Directory.

ATHLETIC DIRECTORS' SEMINAR

The purpose of this annual seminar is to allow new and experienced AD's to meet, share ideas and formulate goals concerning administration of their CYO programs. The Seminar will be Saturday, September 11, at the St. Joseph Center for the Deaf, 25580 Campus Drive, Hayward. (Close to Cal State East Bay) Besides providing a great experience, attendance at the Seminar will certify AD's and their assistants to coach this year. A Seminar flyer is included! INSURANCE

CYO YOUTH AND SPORTS ACTIVITY INSURANCE: Information on the CYO Youth and Sports Activity Insurance (excess medical coverage) will be mailed and will also be sent to pastors. The Insurance program is mandatory for all programs that include children not attending the parish Catholic School.

CERTIFICATES OF INSURANCE: Gyms and facilities (other than parish gyms) usually require proof of insurance. To obtain a "Certificate of Insurance" the CYO athletic director (only) must complete the "Proof of Insurance Request Form for Certificate of Insurance" *and return it to the CYO Office with a copy of the application or contract for use of the facilities and documentation of any minimum insurance requirements.* Process time for certificates can be three weeks. Coaches or others should **never** contract for the use of facilities.

NATIONAL FEDERATION COACHES INSURANCE: Membership in the "National Federation Interscholastic Coaches Association." is offered to youth coaches and includes personal liability coverage with other benefits. A registration form is enclosed.

GIRLS CYO VOLLEYBALL

Girls CYO Volleyball teams may begin practice on Friday, October 1 and league play may begin on Saturday, November 6. If your parish participates in Girls Volleyball, keep these dates in mind when setting parish practice schedules and basketball league schedules.
